Jeffrey Devries, MD, MPH, serves as Vice President for Graduate Medical Education (GME) in Beaumont Health, and Director of GME at Beaumont - Royal Oak/Troy/Grosse Pointe. He is Associate Dean for Graduate Medical Education and Professor of Pediatrics at the Oakland University William Beaumont (OUWB) School of Medicine. In his role as Vice President, he oversees 88 ACGME-accredited Residency and Fellowship programs, educating 930 trainees across 8 hospital campuses in the metropolitan Detroit area. He is a member of Beaumont Health's Education Steering and Operations Committee, where he works in close collaboration with Beaumont's Directors of Undergraduate and Continuing Medical Education.

Dr. Devries received B.S. and M.D. degrees from the University of Michigan, and a Master's of Public Health from the University of Rochester (NY). He completed Pediatric Residency at Children's Hospital of Michigan, and a Robert Wood Johnson-sponsored General Pediatrics Academic Development Fellowship at the University of Rochester (NY). He has held prior leadership positions in the Henry Ford Health System, Oakwood Healthcare System, and Children's Hospital of Michigan. Immediately prior to his arrival at Beaumont, he served as Medical Director of Michigan's largest Medicaid managed care plan.

At the national level, Dr. Devries has served on the Board of Directors of the major pediatric academic society -- the Academic Pediatric Association (APA) -- and has chaired its Education Committee. He has earned multiple teaching awards from medical students and residents, community service leadership awards, and the APA's first-ever "Award for Innovation in Pediatric Education". He serves on the Steering Committee and Program Planning Committee of the Association of American Medical Colleges' (AAMC's) Group on Resident Affairs (GRA). He is also President-Elect of the American Healthcare Professionals & Friends for Medicine in Israel (APF). Regionally, Dr. Devries is Immediate Past-President of the Southeast Michigan Center for Medical Education (SEMCME), one of the nation's largest teaching consortia.
