Internal Medicine Committee Charter

Purpose

To support the mission, vision and values of SEMCME through the development and execution of programs and services related to Internal Medicine.

Goals and Objectives

- Annually develop and submit a program schedule and budget for approval.
- Identify critical resources and support needed for the function of the committee.
- Confirm meeting schedule and composition of the committee.

Projects/Initiatives

- Develop programs to meet the needs of the discipline of Internal Medicine inclusive of its faculty, residents in training and practitioners.
- 2022/2023 Initiatives:
 - IM Professionalism Survey
 - IM Milestones Professionalism Workshop
 - Annual IM Board Review Course
- Identify and engage appropriate subject matter experts.
- Confirm alignment with ACGME requirements.
- Evaluate effectiveness of program design and execution (particularly when conducted virtually).

Measures of Success

The committee will measure the success of their initiatives through:

- Member hospital participation

- Feedback from program directors and DIOs
- Improving Board Pass rates of residents

Responsibilities of Committee Members

- Attend and actively participate in committee meetings.
- Facilitate and support the committee in meeting its purpose.
- Monitor and assist in the implementation of the committee's measures of success.
- Communicate and update institutional leadership on committee and SEMCME efforts.

Structure and Operations

- Committee members will determine meeting dates, times and frequency that best meet its purpose and goals.
- The SEMCME Board of Directors will approve committee membership on an annual basis.
- Committee shall consist of representatives from each SEMCME member institution and DIOs may submit names for consideration.
- Membership will be balanced and be representative of a wide variety of individuals from various backgrounds.
- A committee chair, who may be recommended by the committee and approved on an annual basis by the SEMCME Board of Directors, shall lead the committee.
- The committee chair will serve a 2-year term up to a maximum of 3 terms.
- Committee members will serve a 2-year term that is renewable if desired.
- Meeting minutes will be recorded, reviewed and approved.
