Dr. Heidi Kromrei is the Associate Designated Institutional Official (ADIO) and Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs at the Detroit Medical Center (DMC). She is also Director of Osteopathic Medical Education for the DMC Osteopathic Division. Dr. Kromrei, along with the DMC DIO, is responsible for monitoring and oversight of the accreditation and educational activities of the DMC's nearly 100 residency and fellowship programs with more than 1000 residents and fellows enrolled.
