Tsveti Markova, M.D., F.A.A.F.P. is the Associate Dean for Graduate Medical Education (GME) and Designated Institutional Official for Wayne State University and Ascension Crittenton Hospital. She is also a Professor and Chair of the Wayne State University School of Medicine's Department of Family Medicine and Public Health Sciences. Dr. Markova is the Lead Co-Principle Investigator of the Michigan Area Health Education Center.

Dr. Markova has been a medical educator for more than 20 years. Throughout her career, she has been honored by many awards, including the prestigious 2011 Parker J. Palmer "Courage to Teach" ACGME award, most recently the 2018 Parker J. Palmer "Courage to Lead" Award, "Best Doctors in America", and 2008 MAFP Educator of the Year Award. She led QI institutional initiative which received the 2013 Alliance Innovation Award by the Alliance of Independent Medical Centers (AIAMC). Dr. Markova has been actively engaged in national, state and regional levels through the AAMC Group on Resident Affairs (Chair Elect), AIAMC (Board Member), MAFP, and Southeast Michigan Center for Medical Education, among others. She has authored more than 70 peer-reviewed publications in the areas of medical education innovation, learning environment and teamwork, quality improvement and health care disparities.
